

Recommendations for the Use of the Data Holder Rights Exercise Form

The reason for including this form (see page 2) is aimed at improving communication and assisting in the execution of the request for the exercise of rights as established in the new General Data Protection Regulations (RGPD) and it is recommended by the AEPD. PADEL NUESTRO (PN) presents the following form to exercise the right to limit the **Use of Data for certain purposes**. We should inform you that the data that has been stored from you derived from the forms or communications established for this purpose, will be blocked in order to be able to prove the management and maintenance of the same (data / documents) for a period of 5 years.

The right to oppose certain purposes of data use is one of the rights that the Organic Law of Protection of Personal Data (LOPD) and the General Regulation of Data Protection recognizes citizens so that they can control the use that is made of your personal data. This exercise is very personal, so it can only be requested by the person concerned, who should contact the company that knows or presumes that they have their information. The limitation of treatment means that, at the request of the interested party, the processing operations that in each case would correspond will not be applied to your personal data.

The limitation can be requested when: (a) The interested party has exercised the rights of rectification or opposition and the person in charge is in the process of determining whether to respond to the request. (b)

The treatment is illegal, which would determine the deletion of the data, but the interested party is opposed to it. (c) The data are no longer necessary for the treatment, which would also determine its deletion, but the interested party requests the limitation because it needs them for the formulation, exercise or defense of claims.

In the time that the limitation lasts, the person in charge can only deal with the affected data, beyond its conservation: (a) With the consent of the interested party (b) For the formulation, exercise or defense of claims (c) To protect the rights of another natural or legal person (d) For reasons of important public interest of the Union or of the corresponding Member State

Procedure to use this form:

1. Notification by postal mail:
